Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 63 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO
CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE REGULATION AND LICENSURE OF
GERONTOLOGISTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Auditor to
conduct a sunrise review of the licensure of gerontologists and to
submit findings and recommendations to the Legislature prior to
the Regular Session of 2018.

Your Committee notes that Section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised
Statutes, requires certain regulatory measures to be referred to
the Auditor for analysis if the regulatory measure being
considered for enactment would subject unregulated professions and
vocations to licensing upon enactment.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 63 and
recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Consumer
Protection & Commerce.
