Your Committees on Water & Land and Ocean, Marine Resources,  
& Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 80 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ESTABLISH A WORKING GROUP TO  
STUDY THE POTENTIAL TRANSFER OF MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF  
THE ROYAL MAUSOLEUM AT MAUNA 'ALA TO ONE OR MORE APPROPRIATE  
NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of  
Land and Natural Resources to establish a working group to study  
the potential transfer of management and maintenance of the Royal  
Mausoleum at Mauna 'Ala to one or more appropriate nonprofit  
organizations.

Kamehameha Schools, Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, and  
two individuals testified in support of this measure. The Center  
for Hawaiian Sovereignty Studies testified in opposition to this  
measure. The Department of Land and Natural Resources commented  
on this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by adding the  
Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs and the Royal Societies - 'Aha  
Hipu'u to the list of participants in the working group, and  
specifying that the Department of Land and Natural Resources will


