entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE FEDERAL FUNDING POLICY  
STUDY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to address the federal funding  
policy study mandated by Act 225, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016.

More specifically, this measure amends Act 225, Session Laws  
of Hawaii 2016, by:

- (1) Changing the agency responsible for preparing the  
federal funding policy study from the Office of the  
Governor to the Department of Budget and Finance;
- (2) Specifying the fiscal period to be covered by the study  
and the deadline for the study's submission to the  
Governor and Legislature; and
- (3) Amending the appropriation to conform to the change of  
agency and applicable fiscal year.

The Department of Budget and Finance supported this measure.




Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2030, to facilitate further discussion;
- (2) Changing the appropriation to an unspecified amount; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
