Sir:

Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred
S.B. No. 443 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS OF
CANDIDATE COMMITTEES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to repeal the
requirement of reporting contributions of more than \$100 in the
organizational report of a candidate committee.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Campaign Spending Commission. Your Committee received
testimony in opposition to this measure from one individual.

Your Committee finds that existing law requires candidate
committees to disclose their contributions in periodic disclosure
reports pursuant to sections 11-333 and 11-338, Hawaii Revised
Statutes. The Campaign Spending Commission indicated in its
written testimony that the organizational report of a candidate
committee contains only directory-type information that does not
have space for a candidate committee to disclose contributions.
Thus, this measure deletes an unnecessary requirement.

Your Committee notes that while this measure may appear to
reduce the public availability of information concerning campaign
contributions, the statutory revisions contained in this measure
relate only to organizational reports and have no adverse impact
on full public disclosure of campaign contributions. This measure
is intended only to address statutory redundancy and to allow the



Campaign Spending Commission to process initial organizational reports more efficiently.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 443 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.


