Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
S.B. No. 887, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ENHANCED 911 SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to apply a surcharge for
enhanced 911 services on prepaid wireless telecommunications
service in a manner equivalent to the enhanced 911 surcharge
applicable to other cellular and telephone services.

The Department of Accounting and General Services, Enhanced
911 Board, Office of Enterprise Technology Services, Honolulu
Police Department, County of Hawaii Police Department, Maui Police
Department, and a concerned individual supported this measure.
The Retail Merchants of Hawaii opposed this measure. The Tax
Foundation of Hawaii offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2090, to promote
further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
