Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
S.B. No. 946, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY TO ADJUST
PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSING FEES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to extend the authority of
certain boards, commissions, and other government agencies to
adjust fees or other nontax revenues assessed or charged thereby
for the following, subject to the Governor's approval:

- (1) Six new licensing areas: athletic trainers, behavior analysts, mixed martial arts, respiratory therapists, uniform athlete agents, and veterinary technicians; and
- (2) Any board, commission, program, or entity created pursuant to Title 25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and assigned to or administratively placed within the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs.

The Professional and Vocational Licensing Division of the
Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs supported this
measure.
