Your Committee on Intrastate Commerce, to which was referred
S.B. No. 947, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CITATIONS FOR BEAUTY CULTURE
VIOLATIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to improve the regulation of
beauty culture licensees and permittees by:

- (1) Authorizing the Department of Commerce and Consumer
Affairs to issue citations for certain violations of
laws and administrative rules that apply to beauty
culture licensees and permittees; and
- (2) Establishing a process for cited beauty culture
licensees and permittees to contest the citation.

The Regulated Industries Complaints Office of the Department
of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and the Board of Barbering and
Cosmetology supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2090, to promote further discussion.
