Sir:

Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred  
S.C.R. No. 42 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A  
TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE  
SUBMERGED LANDS AT KANEOHE, KOOLAUPOKO, OAHU, FOR THE  
MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE EXISTING SEAWALL, BOAT RAMP,  
AND PIER, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE  
EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to authorize the  
issuance of a term, non-exclusive easement for the portion of  
state submerged lands fronting the property identified as tax map  
key number: (1) 4-4-018: seaward of 072, Kaneohe, Koolaupoko,  
Oahu, for the maintenance and repair of the existing seawall, boat  
ramp, and pier, and for use, repair, and maintenance of the  
existing improvements constructed thereon, pursuant to section  
171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Land and Natural Resources. Your Committee  
received testimony in opposition to this measure from one  
individual.

Your Committee finds that, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii  
Revised Statutes, the Board of Land and Natural Resources may  
lease submerged lands with the prior approval of the Governor and



the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution. Your Committee further finds that on April 24, 2015, under agenda item D-15, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant of a fifty-five-year non-exclusive easement to resolve the encroachment of portions of the seawall, boat ramp, and pier identified in this measure. Your Committee notes that the fair market value of the easement is \$36,000 as determined by an independent appraisal, and that the current property owner has remitted payment to the State. Your Committee concludes that the easement is necessary for the maintenance and repair of the existing seawall, boat ramp, and pier, and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 42 and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.


