RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES PROGRAM

ADMINISTRATION.

Restructures the Hawaii Invasive Species Council as the Hawaii Invasive Species Authority, administratively attached to the Department of Agriculture, to coordinate implementation of the Hawaii Interagency Biosecurity Plan and to improve coordination of the State's invasive species prevention, early detection, rapid response, control, enforcement, and outreach programs. Appropriates funds to implement the Authority and relevant interagency invasive species

projects. Effective 7/1/2017.

HB 1017 Status

RELATING TO THE PESTICIDE USE REVOLVING FUND.

AGR, EEP, FIN

Increase the Pesticide Use Revolving Fund threshold from \$250,000 to \$1,000,000. Allows for additional pesticide education specialists and future research and studies.
