Proposed HD1: Amends the offense of cruelty to animals in the first degree to include indigenous birds and cruelty to animals in the second degree to include restraints to dogs that deprive them of necessary food or sustenance. <u>SB 804, SD1</u> <u>Proposed HD1</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HAWAII PESTICIDES LAW. Proposed HD1: Increases the amount of moneys from the pesticide use revolving fund that the Department of Agriculture may retain to carry out its statutory mandate. Establishes disclosure requirements for commercial agricultural pesticide use.	AGR, FIN
