<a href="#"><u>SB 398</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CANCER. Creates the colorectal cancer screening and awareness pilot program within the department of health and appropriates funds for the program. Repeals on 6/30/2020.	CPH, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 405</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO EARLY INTERVENTION. Appropriates funds for the procurement of, and maintenance and training for, a web-based data system in the department of health's early intervention section.	CPH, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 305</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES. Specifies that video monitoring and recording of medical marijuana dispensary and production center premises shall be retained for a period of forty-five days.	CPH, JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 325</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA. Specifies that ten per cent of tax revenues collected from medical marijuana dispensaries shall be allocated to the mental health and substance abuse special fund.	CPH, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 404</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CHAPTER 245, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES. Imposes an excise tax on electronic smoking devices, disposable electronic smoking devices, reusable electronic smoking devices, and e-liquid sold by a wholesaler or dealer on and after 01/01/2018. Requires retailers engaged in the retail sale of cigarettes, tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, or e-liquid to obtain a retail tobacco permit. Increases the license fee for wholesalers or dealers of cigarettes, tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, and e-liquid. Increases the retail tobacco permit fee for retailers of cigarettes, tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, and e-liquid.	CPH, WAM
