SB 366 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE HAWAII RATEPAYER PROTECTION ACT. Requires, on or before 1/1/2020, the public utilities commission to establish performance incentive and penalty mechanisms that directly tie electric utility revenues to the utility's achievement on performance metrics.	CPH
SB 119 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PAYMENT OF RENT. Requires landlords to disclose in writing the tenant's ability to establish a new due date for rent payment if the tenant receives public assistance. Establishes a cap of five per cent on late rent payment fees.	CPH
SB 266 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TRAVEL AGENCIES. Requires travel agencies that operate as sole proprietorships to file proof of professional liability and errors and omissions insurance as a condition of registration or renewal.	CPH
SB 1237 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INSURANCE. Exempts individuals selling only insurance for property stored at a self-service storage facility from obtaining a license as an insurance producer provided that specific requirements are met.	CPH
SB 1299 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CHARTER TOUR OPERATORS. Provides that charter tour operators may deposit sums subject to section 468L-23, HRS, in a trust account maintained in a federally insured financial institution serving as the depository bank for a public charter program subject to federal regulations.	CPH
