HB552 HD1 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE. CPH, WAM

(HSCR845) Ensures that benefits of the Affordable Care Act are preserved under State law in the case of repeal of the ACA by Congress.

Preserves the individual mandate, minimum essential benefit requirements, extended dependent coverage, and prohibitions on preexisting condition exclusions and gender discrimination in premiums and costs. Establishes a trust fund and procedures to reimburse insurers for unrecouped costs of providing minimal

essential insurance benefits. (HB552 HD1)
