| <a href="#">HB 177, HD2</a><br><a href="#">(HSCR1037)</a><br><a href="#">Status &amp;<br/>Testimony</a> | RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.<br>Prohibits associations of apartment owners, boards of directors, managing agents, resident managers, condominium owners, and condominium owners from retaliating or discriminating against a condominium owner, board member, managing agent, resident manager, or association employee who files a complaint; acts in furtherance of a complaint, report, or investigation of an alleged violation of the State's condominium laws or a condominium's governing documents; or exercises or attempts to exercise any right as a condominium owner. (HB177 HD2) | CPH |
| <a href="#">HB 1299, HD1</a><br><a href="#">(HSCR949)</a><br><a href="#">Status &amp;<br/>Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Authorizes a pharmacy to provide a customized patient medication package to any patient of an institutional facility or any member of the general public, subject to certain conditions. (HB1299 HD1)  | CPH |
| <a href="#">HB 558, HD1</a><br><a href="#">(HSCR1003)</a><br><a href="#">Status &amp;<br/>Testimony</a> | RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF SECTION 325-15, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.<br>Repeals Section 325-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, which requires United States citizens or nationals to submit a medical examination report to the Department of Health within sixty days of returning to the State under certain conditions. (HB558 HD1)  | CPH |
