<u>HB255</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LOCALLY GROWN FOOD. Establishes the farm to school grant program to provide grants to farmers participating in the Hawaii farm to school program. Creates the farm to school grant program special fund. Makes an appropriation.	EDN, AGR, FIN
<u>HB307</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ALTERNATIVE JUVENILE EDUCATION. Appropriates funds to the department of education for two alternative schools to provide ongoing education to juveniles involved in the justice system or at-risk of involvement in the justice system. Appropriation.	EDN, JUD, FIN
<u>HB470</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATED TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES. Authorizes the board of education to contract for private groundskeeping services for public library properties.	EDN, LAB, FIN
<u>HB547</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Establishes an income tax credit for host families of foreign exchange individuals.	EDN, VMI, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.



Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:
