<u>HB 480</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Makes appropriations for personnel and equipment for the Hawaii Community College Agriculture Program.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 474</u> <u>(HSCR40)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RAT LUNGWORM DISEASE. Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii at Hilo, the department of health, department of land and natural resources, and department of agriculture for programs, studies, and activities related to rat lungworm disease.	AGR, HED, FIN
<u>HB 519</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Authorizes revenues in the UH commercial enterprises revolving fund to be expended for costs and expenses associated with food services.	HED, FIN



<u>HB 450</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CORAL. Requires UH to conduct a study on the effects of sunscreen on Hawaii's coral reefs. Appropriates funds.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 794</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENERGY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Establishes the University of Hawaii green special fund within UH to reduce energy consumption and costs. Requires UH to submit annual report to legislature.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 1585</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds to UH for positions to implement capital improvement projects.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 609, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR37)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds for a permanent full-time associate professor and a permanent full-time associate specialist position within the University of Hawaii Center on Aging. (HB609 HD1)	HUS, HED, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

PAPER: 10 copies (including an original) to Room 326 in the State Capitol;

FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 808-586-6511 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through the website); or

WEB: For testimony less than 10MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.


