Changes the name of the Board of Dental Examiners to the Board of Dentistry and Dental Hygiene. Beginning on 7/1/2018, changes the board composition by increasing dental hygienist representation and ensuring Oahu and neighbor island representation among dental

hygienist members. (SD1)
