<u>HB 89, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR841)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE HOSPITAL SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM. Continues the Hospital Sustainability Program for two years. Appropriates funds out of the Hospital Sustainability Program Special Fund for Fiscal Years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019. (HB89 HD1)	HMS/CPH, WAM
<u>HB 90, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR776)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE NURSING FACILITY SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM. Extends the Nursing Facility Sustainability Program for two years. Appropriates funds out of the Nursing Facility Sustainability Program Special Fund for fiscal year 2017-2018 and fiscal year 2018-2019. (HB90 HD1)	HMS/CPH, WAM
<u>HB 1396, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR1030)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO COMMUNITY CARE FOSTER FAMILY HOMES. Authorizes the Department of Health, working in consultation with the Department of Human Services, to allow two private-pay individuals to be cared for in the same community care foster family home if certain requirements are met.
