HB 1009, HD3 (HSCR1067) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE LANDLORD TENANT CODE. Exempts residence in a structure or on a property directly controlled by the Hawaii Public Housing Authority from the requirements of the residential landlord-tenant code. (HB1009 HD3)	HOU, CPH
