<u>SB 1240, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR530)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO AQUATIC LIFE. Requires DLNR to submit proposed legislation to the legislature by the 2019 regular session including a definition of "sustainable", a policy for sustainable collection practices of near shore aquatic life, and limits on collection. (SD1)	WTL, JDL
<u>SB 1150, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR131)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PRESERVING CORAL REEFS. Prohibits the use or application of sunscreen, sunblock, or cosmetic containing oxybenzone while on a beach or in the ocean.	WTL, JDL
<u>SB 700</u> <u>(SSCR41)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY. Amends the offense of cruelty to animals in the first degree to include indigenous birds.	AEN, JDL
