<u>HB 110, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR738)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS. Makes appropriation for the public employment cost items and cost adjustments for employees of the various legislative agencies. (HB110 HD1)	JDL, WAM
<u>HB 73, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR231)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS. Makes housekeeping amendments to Section 14 of Act 48, SLH 2016, by removing reference to subsections. (HD1)	JDL
<u>HB 74, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR232)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. Replaces a requirement that the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate must jointly request legal representation for a legislative office before that office may receive legal representation with a requirement that allows either the Speaker's request or the President's request, as appropriate, to constitute a sufficient request. (HB74 HD1)	JDL
<u>HB 594, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR899)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE MARITIME INDUSTRY GRANT PROGRAM. Establishes within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism the Maritime Industry Grant Program to enhance maritime productivity and workforce development. (HB594 HD1)	JDL, WAM

Establishes a Kapolei jobs initiative pilot program that offers incentives to increase the number of businesses willing to establish themselves or open a new location in the Kapolei region. Establishes a tax credit, until 12/31/2024, as part of the Kapolei jobs initiative pilot program.	JDL, WAM
