| <p><b><u>HB 213, HD1</u></b><br/><a href="#">(HSCR739)</a><br/><a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a></p> | <p>RELATING TO FAMILY LEAVE.<br/>Permits an employee to take family leave in order to care for the employee's sibling with a serious health condition or upon the death of an employee's child, spouse, reciprocal beneficiary, sibling, or parent. Specifies notice and certification requirements. (HB213 HD1)</p> | <p>JDL, WAM</p> |
