<u>HB 1066</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND EXEMPTION FROM THE INSURANCE CODE. Expands the exemption of the EUTF from the insurance code for the design of benefit plans offered by the EUTF.	LAB, FIN
<u>HB 1064</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO UNCLAIMED PROPERTY OF THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND. 
