LAB, FIN HB 310 Authorizes a nonvoting county representative to participate in Status collective bargaining negotiations for county employees. Reduces the number of votes the governor has from 4 to 1 for negotiations involving police officers and firefighters. Requires the respective Mayor to provide timely collective bargaining negotiation updates to the applicable county council. RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. LAB, FIN HB 332 **Status** Establishes the right for a representative of each county council to be present as a non-voting participant in negotiations with bargaining units if the relevant county has employees in the particular bargaining unit. Requires the mayor or mayor's representative to provide timely updates relating to bargaining unit negotiations to the county councils. Amends the number of votes allotted to the Governor for collective bargaining negotiations with units (11) and (12). LAB, FIN RELATING TO SALARIES. HB 811 Repeals payroll day for public officers and employees by requiring Status them to be paid pursuant to a predicted payroll schedule, rather than an after-the-fact payroll schedule. MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT LAB, FIN HB 110 COST ITEMS. Status Makes appropriation for the public employment cost items of and cost adjustments for employees of the various legislative agencies.
