Allows lessors of rental motor vehicles to pass on to lessees a government assessed fee. Defines government assessed vehicle fee and vehicle license recovery fee. Requires a report by the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. Sunsets on June 30, 2018. (HB735 HD2)	TRE/CPH, WAM
<a href="#">HB 1593, HD1</a> <a href="#">(HSCR860)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE. Establishes the Clean Energy Savings Jump Start Program, Clean Energy Savings Jump Start Fund, and Energy Storage System Rebate Program. Deletes the Public Utilities Commission's approval authority relative to the Green Infrastructure Loan Program. Appropriates funds. (HB1593 HD1)	TRE/CPH, WAM
