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| <u>HB 1378, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR920)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO HIGHWAYS. Requires the Department of Transportation to develop plans for the construction of secondary access roads for the Waianae district of leeward Oahu. Appropriates funds. (HB1378 HD1) | TRE, WAM |
| <u>HB 591, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR897)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO THE CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE TAX CREDIT. Includes structures, machinery, equipment, and capital assets in the definition of capital infrastructure costs for the Capital Infrastructure Tax Credit. Sets cap on credit per taxable year per qualified infrastructure tenant. Specifies that excess tax credits may be carried forward. Recaptures credit if qualified infrastructure tenant fails to relocate within a certain period of time after executing a lease with the Department of Transportation. Specifies taxpayer reporting requirements. (HB591 HD1) | TRE, WAM |
| <u>HB 727, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1047)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES. Allows motorcycle and motor scooter lane filtering. (HB727 HD1) | TRE, JDL |
| <u>HB 1507, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR775)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO CROSSWALKS. Requires the Department of Transportation to establish a Community Crosswalks Pilot Program to design and implement specially painted crosswalk in neighborhoods. Appropriates funds for the pilot program. Creates a Community Crosswalks Pilot Program Special Fund. (HB1507 HD1) | TRE, WAM |
| <u>HB 946, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR993)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u> | RELATING TO HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE LANES. Specifies that an unauthorized person who drives in a high occupancy vehicle lane shall be subject to a \$150 fine. (HB946 HD1) | TRE, WAM |
