<u>SB 698</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LANDS. Requires an owner or occupier to provided notice to county agencies when subdividing and leasing agricultural land. Grants county and state agencies the implicit right to enter property to investigate for violations of and compliance with agricultural subdivision and lease qualifications.	WTL/AEN/PSM, WAM
<u>SB 635</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO WATER CONSERVATION. Establishes a two-year water conservation financial assistance pilot program to provide financial assistance to county-owned public water systems.	WTL/PSM/AEN, WAM
<u>SB 481</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LANDS. Provides grants-in-aids to the counties for the purpose of identifying and mapping important agricultural lands.	WTL/AEN/PSM, WAM
