RELATING TO LANDS CONTROLLED BY THE STATE. WTL/ETT/HOU,
Authorizes the department of land and natural resources and the WAM
Hawaii community development authority to negotiate and
execute ninety-nine year leases on the department's and
authority's lands located within one-half mile of the city and
county of Honolulu's planned rail transit stations, provided that
affordable housing is included in the development plan for the
lands to be leased. Sunsets on 6/30/50.
