HB 839, HD1 (HSCR877) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES. Requires the Auditor to conduct an audit of specified divisions of the Department of Land and Natural Resources. Appropriates funds. (HB839 HD1)	WTL, WAM
HB 840, HD1 (HSCR878) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES. Requires the Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Land Division. Appropriates funds for necessary staff positions. (HB840 HD1)	WTL, WAM
HB 633, HD1 (HSCR975) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ASSISTING DAM AND RESERVOIR OWNERS. Clarifies that aboveground freshwater storage tanks are included in the definition of "appurtenant works" for the purpose of authorizing the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds to assist dam and reservoir owners. (HB633 HD1)	WTL, WAM
