HB790, HD1 RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

EEP/AGR, CPC

Establishes disclosure and public notification requirements for outdoor application of restricted use pesticides in various sensitive areas or by large-scale, outdoor commercial agricultural operations. (HB790 HD1)

HB1299, HD1 RELATING TO HEALTH.

HLT, FIN

Authorizes a pharmacy to provide a customized patient medication package to any patient of an institutional facility or any member of the general public, subject to certain conditions. (HB1299 HD1)

HB1580, HD1 RELATING TO ENERGY.

EEP, FIN

Establishes a clean ground transportation benchmark framework to maximize consumer fuel savings, including a near term 2025 target encouraging electric vehicle infrastructure buildout supporting Hawaii's goal for the reduction and ultimate elimination of the use of imported fuels for ground transportation. Directs the department of transportation to collaborate with the state energy office to develop recommendations to achieve those benchmarks. (HB1580 HD1)

HB1593, HD1 RELATING TO GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE.

EEP, FIN

Establishes the Clean Energy Savings Jump Start Program, Clean Energy Savings Jump Start Fund, and Energy Storage System Rebate Program. Deletes the Public Utilities Commission's approval authority relative to the Green Infrastructure Loan Program. Appropriates funds. (HB1593 HD1)
