House Concurrent Resolution 194/House Resolution 122 urges the United States (U.S.) Army Corps of Engineers and the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to collaborate to create a mechanism for generating water circulation in Pokai Bay on Leeward Oahu. The Department acknowledges the intent, however, respectfully opposes these resolutions due to the lack of funding and resources.

Any project, whether executed in partnership with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or by the Department, would require funding. There is no funding available to the Department at this time to accomplish the intent of these resolutions whether to provide funds to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to meet cost sharing requirements or for the Department to acquire the services of a consultant to conduct studies.
