

SB 1014

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.

Expands authority of the Director of Transportation over required motor vehicle and motor carrier vehicle inspections in the State. Upgrade the methods and procedures of state motor vehicle inspections because the current system is inefficient in that legislation needs to be passed every time an inspection fee is amended. Also, clarifies the distinction between the inspection certificate expiration data and the vehicle's insurance expiration date.

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS

Senate Committee on Transportation and Energy

The Department of Transportation strongly **supports** S.B.1014 that allows expanded authority of the Director of Transportation over required motor vehicle and motor carrier vehicle inspections in the State by upgrading the methods and procedures of state motor vehicle inspections.

The current motor carrier vehicle inspection program is inefficient in that it requires legislation to be passed every time a change to the program is desired, such as the amendment for an inspection. Amending the administrative rules is a more efficient means of making changes to the program and still allows for input from the public. This bill provides the director the authority to make program changes using the process established pursuant to Chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
