As a member of the Deaf Community voters whom are directly impacted by this Bill, I do agree that current Open Captioning services has made a significant change in my way of enjoying the movie theater. Now I can go to the cinema and appreciate the entertainment made accessible. Furthermore, this service significantly aids fellow voters whose first language is not written English. Given the numerous tangible benefits in the months since passing the law mandating open captioning in cinemas, **I strongly support HB 1156 and its companion measure, HB475**, in deleting the sunset date for this law.

One of the challenges we have as Deaf community voters is the short-lived provision of accessible services, be they telecommunications devices or Real-Time Captioning technology or cinema open captioning features. As a result of the timelines provided, We The Deaf People are often back at square one without further progress supporting our accessibility needs compared to our life-long Deaf conditions.

It would be so much better to adjust current provisions of accessibility to evolve as the technology evolves at blistering speed, rather than terminate them entirely. This is why closed-captioning has become a permanent fixture of numerous news and other television programs, even as real-time viewing technology changes from the antennae-based service to today's DVR / Hulu streaming technology.

I ask the committee to vote in **support of SB1156 and HB475**, that deletes the sunset date for open captioning in Hawaii's theaters; a measure that the Deaf community and voters vocally support and need.
