Chairs Brower and Yamane, Vice Chairs Nakamura and Kong, and members of the committee.

This testimony reflects my view alone. The Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA) has not reviewed or acted on this measure.

In my capacity as the HCDA Executive Director I respectfully offer **comments** on SB 715, SD2. There is a dire need for rental housing for low-income families statewide. Regionally in the Kakaako Community Development District, there are three active affordable housing projects that have been approved that would add 365 affordable rentals over the next few years.

Presently, HCDA owns very little underdeveloped or undeveloped land in the district suitable for housing projects. Most of the developable lands suitable for housing projects are owned by private landowners.

Generally, HCDA supports any effort that will further the development of affordable rentals for Hawaii's working families. Adding the Executive Director of HCDA or his designee to the special action team would bring the development expertise to bear.
