SENATE BILL NO. 882 RELATING TO FARM TO SCHOOL MONTH IN HAWAII

Chairpersons Gabbard and Kidani and Members of the Committees:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on SB 882, which designates the month of October of each year as "Farm to School Month" in Hawaii to strengthen and support farm to school initiatives in Hawaii's schools. The Department strongly supports this measure.

The Department is implementing a statewide Farm-to-School Program pursuant to Act 218 (SLH 2015), and sees designating October as a Farm-to-School Month as an opportunity to highlight these efforts and increase participation in the State's growing Farm-to-School initiatives. October has been designated as "National Farm to School Month" by Congress, which lends national support for Farm-to-School initiatives at the same time. Furthermore, October is also Hawaii's Children and Youth Month, (HRS § 8-11). By mirroring this national month designation and tying-in with Hawaii's Child and Youth Month, Hawaii can leverage timely support of these initiatives while expressing its support of greater student health and increased agricultural literacy as a valuable benefit to our children and youth.
