Blue Planet Foundation supports this resolution. The Hawaiian Electric Companies recently submitted a quantitative analysis of energy resource plans. Amongst the key conclusions of this analysis, the modeling efforts of the companies "confirm[ed] that the least-cost pathways to achieving 100 percent renewable energy in Hawaii must take maximum advantage of federal tax subsidies before they phase out completely in the early 2020s."

Based on this, renewable energy projects such as offshore wind should be considered and evaluated on a timescale that would enable this least-cost pathway.
