Thank you for the opportunity to testify in **support** of this important measure. The purpose of this measure is to develop a collaborative plan to best leverage available state and county funds to build affordable housing projects.

The Maui County Council has not had the opportunity to take a formal position on this measure. Therefore, I am providing this testimony in my capacity as an individual member of the Maui County Council.

I **support** this measure for the following reasons:

- 1. As partners in governance, this measure is an opportunity to work together and directly impact the lives of constituents both the state and counties serve. The property involved located at 153 West Kaahumanu Avenue in Kahului is to be used for a mixed-use affordable rental housing project, which can begin once transferred to the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation.
- 2. The property is ideally situated in Central Maui, in close proximity to community amenities such as public transit, schools, shops, businesses, parks and medical clinics.
- 3. The most recent Hawaii Housing Planning Study notes 12,000 housing units on Maui are needed until 2025. There is also an estimated 1,400 homeless individuals on Maui County. The Maui County Council is committed to supporting legislation, methods, and programs that will increase the availability of affordable housing.

For the foregoing reasons, I **support** this measure.

We strongly support <u>SCR 145, SD1/SR67,SD1 r</u>equesting the development of a collaborative plan to best leverage state and county funds to build affordable housing projects and an exploration of the feasibility of transferring a parcel of land in Kahului, Maui to the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation.

Housing and Land Enterprise of Maui, dba Na Hale O Maui is a Nonprofit 501 (c) 3 created to provide affordable housing in Maui County in perpetuity. Our Mission is "To secure and preserve a permanent supply of affordable housing alternatives for low and moderate income households in Maui County." We support the intent of legislation that increases affordable housing in Maui County.

The State of Hawaii Consolidated Plan for Program Years 2015through 2019 estimates the projected housing need for Maui County as approximately 13,994 housing units including 4,857 affordable rentals and 9,137 affordable for sale units.

Approving <u>SCR 145, SD1/SR67,SD1</u> can result in critically needed affordable rentals in Maui County by transferring tax map key 3-7-004-003-0000 (153 Ka'ahumanu Avenue) to HHFDC for future development of a mixed-use affordable rental housing project.

We respectfully request your support of <u>SCR 145, SD1/SR67,SD1</u> to ultimately increase affordable rental housing in Maui.
