THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON Senate Concurrent Resolution 79, Senate Draft 1 requests the authorization to issue a fifty five year term, non-exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged lands seaward of the property identified as Tax Map Key (4) 4-3-009:001, Waipouli, Kawaihau, Kauai for the maintenance and repair of the existing seawall and for the use, repair and maintenance of the The Department of Land and Natural Resources existing improvements thereon.

The prior owners of the abutting property worked with the Department to obtain approval of a 55-year non-exclusive easement for seawall purposes consisting of an area of 852 square feet, more or less, from the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting May 9, 2014, under agenda item D-1, as subsequently amended at a meeting on October 24, 2014, under item D-2. As required by Section 171-53, HRS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) may lease submerged lands "with the prior approval of the Governor and the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution". An independent appraisal obtained by the Department determined the fair market value of the easement at \$25,200.00, and consideration for the easement was paid to the Department.
