A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM FOR THE 2018 GANNENMONO CELEBRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

SECTION 2. This year marks the one hundred fiftieth
anniversary of the arrival in Hawaii of the first group of
organized Japanese immigrants, known as the gannenmono. The
gannenmono, or "first year men", arrived in Hawaii from
Yokohama, Japan, in June 1868. The State should provide
adequate and timely funding to celebrate this historic event.

10 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to the 11 department of business, economic development, and tourism for 12 the 2018 gannenmono celebration. Funds shall be provided to the 13 Japan-America Society of Hawaii to plan, organize, and implement 14 the celebration.

15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for HB2455 CD1 HMS 2018-3912 HB2455 CD1 HMS 2018-3912
