# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SERVICE AREA BOARDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 334-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§334-11 Service area boards. (a) A service area board
- 4 shall be established within the department of health for
- 5 administrative purposes to advise each service area
- 6 administrator. Each board shall consist of nine members
- 7 appointed by the governor, who shall serve for terms to be
- 8 determined by the governor. After the initial appointees, the
- 9 governor shall fill each vacancy on a board by appointing a
- 10 member from a list of four persons submitted by that board,
- 11 except that, if the board is unable to achieve a quorum at two
- 12 consecutive meetings called for the purpose of making such a
- 13 list, the list may be provided by a group of at least seven
- 14 service area consumers and nonproviders of mental health
- 15 services. This group shall consist of all board members willing
- 16 to participate in making the list and other area consumers and
- 17 nonproviders of mental health services to be selected by the
- 18 service area board chairperson and service area administrator.



- 1 Any meeting called for the purpose of making the list shall be
- 2 subject to part I of chapter 92. The members of the board shall
- 3 be service area residents, who are consumers or nonproviders of
- 4 mental health services and service area providers with a
- 5 majority being non-state employees and nonproviders of mental
- 6 health or other health services.
- 7 Each board shall elect a chairperson from among its
- 8 members. All members shall serve without compensation but shall
- 9 be paid their necessary expenses in attending meetings of the
- 10 board.
- 11 (b) Each service area administrator and board, in
- 12 consultation with public and private providers, shall
- 13 participate in the development of comprehensive integrated
- 14 service area plans and budgets. Each board shall advise the
- 15 service area administrator about service area needs to prevent
- 16 and treat mental or emotional disorders, combined mental illness
- 17 substance abuse disorders, and persons afflicted by these
- 18 disorders, and provide advice, guidance, and recommendations to
- 19 both the advisory commission on drug abuse and controlled
- 20 substances, section 329-2, and the state council on mental
- 21 health, section 334-10, as they deem appropriate.

- 2 conformance with the board's planning decisions, the service
- 3 area administrator shall provide a written explanation to the
- 4 board.
- 5 (d) A quorum for purposes of doing business shall consist
- 6 of a majority of the members serving on a board immediately
- 7 before a meeting begins.
- 8 (e) If a quorum is present when a vote is taken, the
- 9 affirmative vote of a majority of the members present shall
- 10 constitute a valid act of a board unless this chapter, part I of
- 11 chapter 92, or the articles or bylaws of the board require the
- vote of a greater number of members."
- 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
