Dear President Kouchi, Speaker Saiki, and Members of the Legislature:

Re: HB2589 HD2 SD1 CD1

HB2589 HD2 SD1 CD1, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES" will become law without my signature, pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the State Constitution.

This bill will authorize the Department of Transportation to designate shoulder lanes upon which motorcycles are allowed to operate when traffic is halted. It will also prohibit the opening of automobile doors that interfere with motorcycles in the shoulder.

The shoulder lane is designated to accommodate stopped vehicles and emergency vehicles on highways, as well as bicycles on arterial roadways. There are significant concerns that this could compromise road safety and create more dangers for operators of all vehicles.

Despite the possible safety concerns, we trust that the Department of Transportation will properly vet which shoulder lanes can be accessible to motorcycles while carefully considering optimal safety measures.
