

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Sections 134-7 to 134-9 and 134-21 to 134-27, except 4 section 134-7(f), shall not apply: 5 (1) To state and county law enforcement officers [+] and 6 corrections officers as defined in section 88-21; 7 provided that such persons are not convicted of an 8 offense involving abuse of a family or household 9 member under section 709-906; 10 (2) To members of the armed forces of the State and of the United States and mail carriers while in the 11 12 performance of their respective duties if those duties 13 require them to be armed; 14 (3) To regularly enrolled members of any organization duly 15 authorized to purchase or receive the weapons from the 16 United States or from the State; provided the members

1		are either at, or going to or from, their places of
2		assembly or target practice;
3	(4)	To persons employed by the State, or subdivisions
4		thereof, or the United States while in the performance
5		of their respective duties or while going to and from
6		their respective places of duty if those duties
7		require them to be armed;
8	(5)	To aliens employed by the State, or subdivisions
9		thereof, or the United States while in the performance
10		of their respective duties or while going to and from
11		their respective places of duty if those duties
12		require them to be armed; and
13	(6)	To police officers on official assignment in Hawaii
14		from any state which by compact permits police
15		officers from Hawaii while on official assignment in
16		that state to carry firearms without registration.

19		other states to carry out this paragraph."
