A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 249-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By amending the definition of "bicycle" to read:
4	""Bicycle" means [every]:
5	(1) A device propelled solely by human power upon which
6	any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen
7	inches in diameter or greater, and including any
8	device generally recognized as a bicycle though
9	equipped with two front or two rear wheels $[-]$; or
10	(2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
11	15 United States Code section 2085."
12	2. By amending the definition of "moped" to read:
13	""Moped" means a device upon which a person may ride which
14	has two or three wheels in contact with the ground, a motor
15	having a maximum power output capability measured at the motor
16	output shaft, in accordance with the Society of Automotive
17	Engineers standards, of two horsepower (one thousand four

- 6 but not operated upon rails but excludes a moped[-] and a low-
- 7 speed electric bicycle."
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 291C-148, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) Unless otherwise prohibited, a bicycle may be driven
- 11 at a speed of ten miles per hour or less on a sidewalk or
- 12 sidewalk area; provided that the driver of the bicycle shall
- 13 yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian and that bicycle riding
- 14 shall be prohibited on sidewalks in business districts [-];
- 15 provided further that low-speed electric bicycle riding shall be
- 16 prohibited on all sidewalks."
- 17 SECTION 5. Section 293-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §293-1[+] Defacing serial numbers, etc., of bicycles.
- 20 It shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully deface, destroy,
- 21 or alter the serial number, a component part number, or

- 1 identification mark of any bicycle, including a low-speed
- 2 electric bicycle as defined under title 15 United States Code
- 3 section 2085, so placed or stamped on any bicycle by the
- 4 manufacturer for the purpose of identifying the bicycle or its
- 5 component parts.
- 6 This section does not prohibit the restoration by an owner
- 7 of an original mark or number, when the restoration is
- 8 authorized in writing by the county treasurer or director of
- 9 finance, nor prevent any manufacturer from placing in the
- 10 ordinary course of business, numbers or marks upon new bicycles
- 11 or new parts thereof. Violation of this section shall be a
- 12 misdemeanor and shall result in a fine of not more than \$500."
- 13 SECTION 6. Section 293-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §293-2[+] Bicycle dealers, records required. All
- 16 persons selling new bicycles [to others], including a low-speed
- 17 electric bicycle as defined under title 15 United States Code
- 18 section 2085, as a business shall keep a record for four years
- 19 after the sale of a bicycle of the name of the purchaser, and
- 20 the serial number, description, and make of the bicycle sold to

- 1 the purchaser. This record may be inspected by the police
- 2 during reasonable business hours."
- 3 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.

Report Title:

Transportation; Bicycles; Low-Speed Electric Bicycles;

Description:

Clarifies the definition of "bicycles" for purposes of county vehicular taxes, highway safety laws, statewide traffic code, and bicycle laws by adding "low-speed electric bicycles" and defining low-speed electric bicycles. Excludes low-speed electric bicycles from the definitions of "moped", "motor vehicle", and "vehicle". Prohibits low-speed electric bicycle riding on all sidewalks.
