A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The department of education shall establish a SECTION 1. 2 pilot program to retrofit the following buildings to meet or 3 exceed the various building codes established for enabling a building to withstand the weather conditions of a category four 4 5 hurricane: Mililani uka elementary school cafeteria; 6 (1)7 (2)Mililani high school gymnasium; Kaleiopuu elementary school cafeteria; 8 (3) 9 (4) Waipahu high school gymnasium; and August Ahrens elementary school cafeteria. 10 (5) SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue 11 12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019 14 for the purpose of retrofitting department of education 15 16 buildings to withstand a category four hurricane pursuant to section 1 of this Act. 17

 education for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
6 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
7 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.
8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
