A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INCOME CHECK-OFF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the demand of Hawaii
- 2 state public library system patrons for library books and
- 3 materials, including electronic resources, is increasing every
- 4 year. Since the initial adoption of the libraries special fund
- 5 income tax check-off in 2003, the collection of the Hawaii state
- 6 public library system has transitioned from a paper-based
- 7 collection to one that includes library materials in a variety
- 8 of different and new formats to keep up with advances in
- 9 technology and in response to the requests of library patrons
- 10 statewide.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to provide an opportunity for
- 12 the public to increase their support of the Hawaii state public
- 13 library system by making a contribution to the libraries special
- 14 fund, which is used to purchase additional library materials for
- 15 the Hawaii state public library system collection.
- SECTION 2. Section 235-102.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

1 "(c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any 2 individual whose state income tax refund for any taxable year is [\$2] \$ or more may designate [\$2] \$ of the refund to be 3 paid over to the libraries special fund established by section 4 312-3.6, when submitting a state income tax return to the 5 6 department. In the case of a joint return of a [husband and 7 wife] married couple having a state income tax refund of [\$4] 8 \$ or more, each spouse may designate that [\$2] \$ be deposited into the special fund. The director of taxation shall 9 **10** revise the individual state income tax form to allow the designation of contributions to the fund on the face of the tax 11 12 return and immediately above the signature lines. If no designation was made on the original tax return when filed, a 13 designation may be made by the individual on an amended return 14 15 filed within twenty months and ten days after the due date for 16 the original return for [such] that taxable year. A designation once made, whether by an original or amended return, may not be 17 18 revoked." SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 19 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050, and
- 2 shall be applicable to taxable years beginning after
- 3 December 31, 2017.
