BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 14-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$14-29 Naming persons voted for in ballots, separate
- 4 ballots. (a) Prior to completing a ballot pursuant to
- 5 subsection (b), each elector shall pledge in writing to name in
- 6 their ballot the candidates designated pursuant to section 14-28
- 7 and shall affix their signature to the pledge.
- 8 <u>(b)</u> The electors shall name in their ballots the person
- 9 voted for as president, and in separate ballots the person voted
- 10 for as vice president.
- 11 (c) An elector who refuses to present a ballot, presents
- 12 an unmarked ballot, or presents a ballot marked in violation of
- 13 the elector's pledge executed pursuant to subsection (a) shall
- 14 be deemed to have resigned, the applicable ballot shall not be
- 15 recorded, and the vacancy shall be filled pursuant to
- 16 section 14-27.
