### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FUEL CELL ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 103D-412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
3	"(b) Beginning January 1, 2010, all state and county
4	entities, when purchasing new vehicles, shall seek vehicles with
5	reduced dependence on petroleum-based fuels that meet the needs
6	of the agency. Priority for selecting vehicles shall be as
7	follows:
8	(1) Electric or plug-in hybrid electric vehicles $[+]$ and
9	[ <del>(2)</del> Hydrogen or] fuel cell <u>electric</u> vehicles;
10	[ <del>(3)</del> ] <u>(2)</u> Other alternative fuel vehicles;
11	[ <del>(4)</del> ] <u>(3)</u> Hybrid electric vehicles; and
12	$\left[\frac{5}{5}\right]$ (4) Vehicles that are identified by the United States
13	Environmental Protection Agency in its annual "Fuel
14	Economy Leaders" report as being among the top
15	performers for fuel economy in their class.
16	(c) For the purposes of this section:
17	"Agency" means a state agency, office, or department.

1	"Alternative fuel" means alcohol fuels, mixtures containing
2	eighty-five per cent or more by volume of alcohols with gasoline
3	or other fuels, natural gas, liquefied petroleum gas, hydrogen,
4	biodiesel, mixtures containing twenty per cent or more by volume
5	of biodiesel with diesel or other fuels, other fuels derived
6	from biological materials, and electricity provided by off-board
7	energy sources.
8	"Covered fleet" has the same meaning as contained in 10
9	Code of Federal Regulations Part 490 Subpart C.
10	"Excluded vehicles" has the same meaning as provided in 10
11	Code of Federal Regulations section 490.3.
12	"Fuel cell electric vehicle" means a zero-emission electric
13	vehicle that uses a fuel cell to convert hydrogen gas and oxygen
14	into electricity to power one or more onboard electric motors to
15	propel the vehicle.
16	"Light-duty motor vehicle" has the same meaning as
17	contained in 10 Code of Federal Regulations Part 490, not
18	including any vehicle incapable of traveling on highways or any
19	vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating greater than eight
20	thousand five hundred pounds."
