

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH A CAMPAIGN TO EDUCATE VISITORS TO THE STATE ABOUT THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF OXYBENZONE SUNSCREEN ON CORAL REEFS AND TO ENCOURAGE VISITORS TO THE STATE TO REFRAIN FROM USING OXYBENZONE SUNSCREENS.

WHEREAS, the decline of coral reefs poses a significant 1 ecological threat worldwide; and 2 3 WHEREAS, while scientists around the world agree that the 4 primary causes of coral decline are related to global warming, 5 agricultural runoff, sewage, and overfishing, recent studies 6 have shown that that oxybenzone, a common sunscreen ingredient, 7 also has detrimental effects on coral reefs; and 8 9 WHEREAS, coral larvae deformity, bleaching, and DNA damage 10 that weaken coral systems' adaptability to climate change have 11 all been attributed to oxybenzone exposure; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the harmful effects of oxybenzone are particularly 14 acute in Hawaiian ocean waters where coral bleaching is 15 occurring at a historic rate never before noted in recorded 16 17 history; and 18 WHEREAS, there are reasonable alternatives to oxybenzone-19 based sunscreens, such as zinc oxide and titanium oxide, that 20 allow beach-users to enjoy the outdoors without compromising sun 21 protection; now, therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 24 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 25 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Tourism 26 Authority is requested to establish a campaign to educate 27 visitors to the State about the harmful effects of oxybenzone 28

sunscreen on coral reefs and to encourage visitors to the State 1 to refrain from using oxybenzone sunscreens; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Tourism Authority is 4 5 requested to submit a report to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 6 2019, on the efforts taken to educate visitors to the State 7 8 about the harmful effects of oxybenzone sunscreen on coral reefs and to encourage visitors to the State to refrain from using 9 oxybenzone sunscreens; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 13 Hawaii Tourism Authority. 14 15 16 17 OFFERED BY: HCR LRB MAR - 9 2018 2
