APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN LAND OWNED BY THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

10	acquired or reserved by the government upon or subsequent to		
11	that date by purchase, exchange, escheat, or the exercise of the		
12	right of e	eminent domain, or any other manner; and

33		major pump station and/or other wastewater facility,
34		as determined by the needs of the City and County of

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1 2 WHEREAS, a draft of this concurrent resolution was submitted to the Office of Hawaiian Affairs at least three 3 4 months prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2018; 5 and 6 WHEREAS, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs duly conducted an 7 8 informational briefing on the sale of Parcel I at a publicly 9 noticed meeting of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs on March 7, 10 2018, in the ahupua'a of Honolulu, moku of Kona, mokupuni of O'ahu; now, therefore, 11 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 14 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the sale of the fee simple 15 interest in certain parcels in Kaka'ako, including tax map key 16 17 no. (1) 2-1-015:061, from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs to the City and County of Honolulu is approved; and 18 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 22 Board of Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs and Mayor of 23 the City and County of Honolulu. 24 25 26
