

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CREATE A MASTER PLAN FOR A PARCEL IN THE NĀNĀKULI-WAI'ANAE COMPLEX AREA THAT WOULD INCLUDE AN ALTERNATIVE LEARNING CENTER AND OTHER FEATURES.

WHEREAS, schools in the Nānākuli-Wai'anae complex area have 1 2 consistently ranked among the lowest performing schools in the 3 State; and 4 WHEREAS, from 2009 to 2013, the Nānākuli-Wai'anae complex 5 area participated in the Zones of School Innovation project, 6 7 which aimed to improve "priority schools", the lowest-performing schools in the State; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Zones of School Innovation project targeted 11 specific areas that served the largest population of native Hawaiian and economically-disadvantaged students in the State; 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS, seven out of ten students in the Nānākuli-Wai'anae 15 complex area are economically-disadvantaged and fall well below 16 17 the state and national averages for educational attainment; and 18 19 WHEREAS, S.B. No. 2393 (Regular Session of 2018) requires the Department of Education (Department) to establish a 20 21 comprehensive plan to establish alternative learning centers in 22 each school complex area in the State; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Department owns vacant lands situated between 25 Wai'anae High School and Wai'anae Boat Harbor, identified as tax map key 850020110000; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, Department officials have expressed support for 29 creating a master plan for the aforementioned parcel, which 30 would feature an alternative learning center, storefront, marine

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1 science learning center, pool, cultural learning park, and other 2 features; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae is, for the most part, situated adjacent to the Department's parcel on state lands; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae started as a houseless 8 encampment and has become a non-profit organization; and 9 WHEREAS, Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae has served and continues to 10 compassionately serve those facing a lack of adequate housing 11 12 and has gained the support of many, including the State Legislature, which honored Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae leader, Twinkle 13 14 Borge, with a floor presentation in 2017; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the State and other organizations continue to assist Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae in its mission, and the Department's 17 18 master plan for its land is not intended to threaten Pu'uhonua o 19 Wai'anae, but rather to focus on the educational needs of 20 students in the Nānākuli-Wai'anae complex area; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the State constructed a halau wa'a (canoe house) on 23 the makai (ocean side) end of the aforementioned parcel, and the non-profit E Ala Voyaging Academy holds a state lease for the 24 halau wa'a; and 25 26 WHEREAS, E Ala Voyaging Academy is seeking to renew its 27 partnership with the Department in the near future and can play 28 a key role in attracting possible at-risk students who would 29 30 enroll in an alternative learning center; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the State awarded funds to the non-profit Na Kama Kai, which seeks to run an ocean education program at the 33 Herbert K. Pililaau Army Recreation Center, located near the 34 35 aforementioned parcel; and 36 37 WHEREAS, Na Kama Kai has participated in discussions with Department officials regarding the need for an alternative 38 learning center in the Nānākuli-Wai'anae complex area and a 39 40 possible collaboration between the Department and Na Kama Kai; 41 and

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1 WHEREAS, Na Kama Kai has partnered with the Department on 2 various ocean safety and education initiatives and seeks to 3 continue and further broaden its partnership with the 4 5 Department; and 6 WHEREAS, there are a variety of other organizations that 7 the Department or Superintendent of Education may identify who 8 can support the effort to establish an alternative learning 9 center; now, therefore, 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 12 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 13 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Education 14 is requested to create a master plan for the parcel identified 15 as tax map key 850020110000, which would include an alternative 16 learning center and may also include a storefront, marine 17 science learning center, pool, cultural learning park, and other 18 features; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department is requested to 21 complete the construction of the alternative learning center and 22 other features for the Nānākuli-Wai'anae complex area on the 23 aforementioned parcel of land by the 2023-2024 school year; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of 27 Education, who, in turn, is requested to transmit a copy to any 28 other organization that the Superintendent or Department of 29 Education determines to be pertinent in supporting the creation 30 of an alternative learning center; Principal of Nānākuli High 31 and Intermediate School; Principal of Wai'anae Intermediate 32 School; Principal of Wai'anae High School; E Ala Voyaging 33 Academy; Herbert K. Pililaau Army Recreation Center; Chief 34 Executive Officer of Na Kama Kai; and Pu'uhonua o Wai'anae 35 Village Leader. 36 37 38 9 OFFERED BY:
